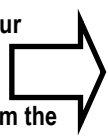

Reminder - Ordinance 55.16(5) It is unlawful for any person owning, controlling or caring for any animal to fail to keep in a clean and sanitary condition the premises and any pen, kennel, shelter, house or person's dwelling or other structure where the animal is at any time kept. At least once every 24 hours or more often if odors or health problems arise, such persons shall pick up any and all feces so as to prevent its accumulation, and same shall be properly disposed of. Feces shall be held in watertight and fly-tight containers pending disposal and shall be disposed of at least once weekly. The animal and place where the animal is maintained shall also be kept free of obnoxious odors and shall be maintained so as not to attract or permit the breeding of flies.
