COLD WEATHER SAFETY

Winter safety and fire prevention

Cold weather brings increased risks from space heaters, frozen pipes, and carbon monoxide. This month, please take a few minutes to check your home's safety and help keep Holstein safe for everyone.

Safety Spotlight #1: Heating & Space Heater Safety

If you use a space heater:

- Keep it at least 3 feet away from furniture, curtains, or bedding
- Plug heaters directly into the wall (avoid extension cords)
- Turn heaters off when leaving the room or going to sleep

Safety Spotlight #2: Help Emergency Responders Reach You Faster

In an emergency, seconds matter. Please:

- Make sure house numbers are visible from the street
- Keep walkways and steps clear of ice and snow when possible
- Fire Hydrant Access - Snowbanks can bury hydrants quickly. If you are able, please help keep nearby hydrants visible and accessible after snowfalls.

Safety Spotlight #3: Carbon Monoxide (CO) Awareness

Carbon monoxide is odorless and dangerous. Midwinter reminders:

- Test your carbon monoxide detectors
- Keep vents and exhaust areas clear of snow
- Never run a vehicle in an enclosed garage
- Never use ovens or stoves for home heating

Ordinance Reminder: No Open Burning Allowed

Residents are reminded that open burning is not allowed within the City of Holstein, including burning of garbage, brush, or other debris. Please use proper disposal methods through approved waste services.

Utility bills: Due - 20th and Late notices - 21st of every month.

2026 PET TAGS - ARE NOW PAST DUE!

- Late fees have now been assessed - **\$22.00 per pet**
- Forms and money must be dropped off at City Hall
- All tags must be picked up at the time of registration
- Rabies shots must be up to date and on file with the City Hall.
- *At this time pet registration fees must be paid separately from utilities*

- Property owners are responsible for keeping sidewalks clear.
- Please remove snow, ice, and other accumulations from sidewalks promptly to help keep walking routes safe for everyone, including students and those with mobility needs.

🚫 Winter Overnight Parking (Nov. 1 – April 1)

To assist with snow removal operations, please remember:

- No parking on city streets during overnight hours throughout the winter season.
- Keeping streets clear helps plows and emergency vehicles move safely and efficiently.
- If heavy snow is expected, residents are encouraged to park off-street whenever possible.

トラック Snowplow Safety & Winter Street Tips

- Please give snowplows extra room and use caution when driving near City equipment.
- Avoid placing snow from driveways back into the street (it creates hazards and makes plowing harder).
- Clearing snow away from hydrants is appreciated and helps first responders in emergencies.

💧 Cold Weather Reminder: Frozen Pipes

- Keep a steady thermostat temperature
- Open cabinet doors under sinks to allow warm air circulation
- If you suspect a water leak or frozen line, contact City Hall as soon as possible
