69.12 NO PARKING FOR SNOW REMOVAL-No person
shall park, abandon or leave unattended any vehicle on any
public street, ally, or city-owned off-street parking area be-
tween the period of **November 1 to April 1 between the**
hours of 2am to 5am. Parking citations will be issued.

**136.03 REMOVAL OF SNOW, ICE AND ACCUMULA-
TIONS**- The abutting property owner shall remove snow,
ice, and accumulations promptly from sidewalks. If a prop-
erty owner does not remove snow, ice or accumulations with-
in a reasonable time, the City may do so and assess the
costs against the property owner for collection in the same
manner as a property tax. The abutting property owner may
be liable for damages caused by failure to remove snow, ice,
and accumulations promptly from the sidewalk.
