### 2024 PRIVATE SWIMMING POOL, HOT TUB, AND SPA REGULATIONS

Private swimming pools, hot tubs, and spas containing more than 24 inches in depth require the following:

- 1. Permit from the City at no charge permits available at City Hall.
- 2. Prior to filling your pool, hot tubs, or spas with water – you will need to schedule an appointment with the City Administrator for an inspection to ensure an acceptable fence or barrier is constructed that meets the following requirements of IPMC section 303.
  - A. Swimming pools, hot tubs, and spas containing more than 24 inches of water must be surrounded by a fence or barrier no less than 48 inches in height above the finished ground level.
  - B. Self-closing and self-latching gate or door device with release on side of gate latch is less than 54 inches above bottom of gate.

Failure to complete the above requirements will result in an immediate municipal infraction with fines up to \$750.00.
