

## 2026 REGULATIONS PRIVATE POOL, HOT TUB & SPA

Private swimming pools, hot tubs, and spas over 24 inches in depth require the following:

- A no-charge permit from the City, available at city hall.
- An inspection appointment with the City Administrator before filling with water to ensure compliance with IPMC section 303:
  - Must have a fence or barrier at least 48 inches high.
  - Requires a self-closing, self-latching gate with the latch positioned below 54 inches.

NON-COMPLIANCE MAY RESULT IN A MUNICIPAL  
INFRACTION WITH FINES UP TO \$750.
