City Ordinances Chapter 55.16

Prohibited Acts by Owners of Animals

It is the duty of every person owning or having the custody or control of any animal to physically restrain the animal within an enclosure or upon a leash when such animal is left unattended outside.

When walking or exercising any animal, for every person owning or having the custody or control of said animal, it is mandatory to carry a container or bag, etc. to pick up animal's feces and dispose of properly in a suitable receptacle. If the animal is at large, it is still the owner or custodian's responsibility to clean up any feces that the animal has left on private or public property.
